- CALLS:** Please report to the starting line ten minutes before your race begins.

- TEAM SCORING:** Team scores will be computed by totaling the top five runners' finish positions. The 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> runners will count as pushers. Runners 8-10 will not be figured into the team scores but will be given official times.



- HIGH SCHOOL INFO:** Oconee County High School will co-host the Georgia Invitational. All high schools competing must be members of the GHSSA.
- COURSE:** All grass, rolling hills, and well-marked with some rough wilderness area
- COURSE INSPECTION:** The course will be available for inspection on Friday, September 18 from 3 pm to 6 pm.
- FINISH LINE:** Please have your runners run all the way through the chute. *The chute area will be restricted to meet officials only.* All runners must wear their assigned numbers on the front of their singlet. A tear-off label is attached to each number. Please do not pin the tear-off label. This label will be removed at the scoring table.
- AWARDS:** Awards will be given to the top 15 individuals and 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in all divisions.
