The 6th and 7th runners will count as pushers. Runners 8-10 will not be figured into the team scores but will be given official times.

- **COURSE:** All grass, rolling hills, and well-marked with some rough wilderness area
- **COURSE INSPECTION:** The course will be available for inspection on Friday, September 18 from 3 pm to 6 pm.
- **FINISH LINE:** Please have your runners run all the way through the chute. *The chute area will be restricted to meet officials only.* All runners must wear their assigned numbers on the front of their singlet. A tear-off label is attached to each number. Please do not pin the tear-off label. This label will be removed at the scoring table.
- **AWARDS:** Awards will be given to the top 15 individuals and 1st & 2nd place teams in all divisions.
- **T-SHIRTS:** T-shirts will be for sale during the meet.
