- Results will be posted shortly after each race, as well as online at www.halfmiletiming.com.
- Top 15 individuals and top 6 teams will advance to the state championships.
- In your packets are bib numbers with matching chips. Please make sure your athletes have the right numbers and chips and that the chips are tied into shoes properly.
- Head FHSAA starter and official is Dan Deering. FHSAA finish line official is Scott Peters.
- Official protest need to be filled out and handed to, Dan Deering, within 30 minutes of the results being posted.
- You can only run 7 runners with your top 5 scoring.
- Watches are allowed to be worn, but please ask your runners to not hit their stop button until well after the finish line so the timing cameras can see their bib number.
- Gate admission is \$7 for every non- competing athlete and parent (mandated by FHSAA). There will be a \$5 per car parking fee as well (carpooling is ideal).
- Coaches need to submit team vehicle parking pass request by Wednesday night at 8p.m. to scott@halfmiletiming.com (maximum of 2 passes per team)
- Chip procedure:
 - Chips need to be picked up and counted at packet pick up.
 - o You will sign the chips out once they are all accounted for
 - o Distribute the chips to your athletes
 - o Once the race is completed collect the chips back from your athletes
 - o Bring the chips back to the table where you signed them out
 - At the table you will count the chips and verify that you have returned all chips that were signed out.
 - Any missing chip will result in \$20 per missing chip fee to the school!

Proper installation for the timing chips



Untie your laces 2-3 loops down.



Put the shoe strings through the 4 holes in the chips and tie them back into the loops.



The shoe is now laying flat on the mid to upper part of the shoe and securely fastened.

Coaches print this out and this will be considered as your attendance card in the coaches meeting. Turn in at packet pick up.
