## Last Minute Race Day Information

- We will be using TWO starting lines for the HIGH SCHOOL race only. Please review with your athletes the starting procedure instructions included in this packet!
- **<u>Timing chips:</u>** Located in your packet you will find your timing chips. Please make sure the correct athlete is wearing the correct chip
- Only seven runners are permitted in the varsity race. All other athletes must run in the junior varsity race
- ♣ All timing chips, including those not used, will be returned to the results table located in front of the clubhouse <u>at the conclusion of your last race</u>. Coaches will not be able to pick up results until their chips are returned and with a results coupon (located in your packet). There will be a charge for any missing chips
- **♣** There is no need to declare which athletes will compete in the varsity and junior varsity race
- Please set up your team camp in the designated team camp areas. Please review the enclosed course map which identifies where you may set up
- Please stay out of the golf clubhouse
- ♣ Please instruct all athletes to stay off the greens and tee boxes
- Enclosed in your packet is a garbage bag for your athletes to use for any trash they have
- ♣ Please have the team parking area cleared by noon.
- Awards will be given to the following:

## Starting Procedure

- ♣ Report to the starting line 10min before your race
- ♣ Each team is permitted one runner on the starting line.
- ♣ Coaches, in order to minimize the risks of call-backs during the start because of the large number of teams entered in the high school division, there will be two separate starting lines.
- ➡ The assigned boxes for the starting line will be based on a random draw. The distance from both starting lines to the merge point is equal.
- ♣ Also, in accordance to the new FHSAA rule changes for 2012-13 season (Rule 9-4-4), the starting procedure will be one long whistle blast followed by the firing of the starting gun.
- ♣ There will be one head starter with two back-up starters.
- ➡ The head starter will give the long whistle blast and fire the starting pistol, indicating the start of the race. He will be standing between both starting lines. The back-up starters, one for each starting line, will give the visual starting commands with the red flags.
