Rules and Reminders:

- 1. The maximum number of contestants which a school may enter is limited to four (4) in each individual event and one (1) team in each relay event.
- 2. The three (3) efforts of each contestant will be recorded in the shot put, discus, triple jump and long jump. The eight (8) contestants with the best performances in the prelims will advance to the finals where they will compete in one flight and receive three (3) more attempts.
- 3. Pole vault competitors will be weighed at the beginning of the event to confirm the proper calibration of their vaulting poles.
- 4. **No jewelry** except watches will be permitted.
- 5. All relays teams must adhere to FHSAA guidelines for proper uniforms.
- 6. The use of electronic devices including cell phones and iPods are not permitted in the competition areas.
- 7. Failure to adhere to the FHSAA rules of competition will result in disqualification of an athlete or relay team.

Registration:

Teams must register their athletes and sign up for events using www.coacho.com. All entries
must be received by the date posted. No changes can take place after this time. Athletes can not
under any circumstances run under another competitors name in this meet. The coaches
meeting will serve as a scratch meeting only. If an athlete is scratched in an event on the day of
the meet, then they are scratched for the entire district meet.
