

- TEAM PACKETS:** Team packets can be picked up between 9-10:30 am underneath the west stands near the weigh in area
- AWARDS:** **Collegiate Invitational/Open**
Champion t-shirts will be awarded to each event winner.
- RULES OF COMPETITION:** NCAA, and USA Track and Field rules shall govern the respective meet.
- CHALLENGE RULE:** If a coach feels an athlete has not legally qualified in a specific event, he may challenge that mark. It will be necessary for the coach of the challenged athlete to be able to prove the validity of the mark submitted. The athlete will be disqualified from the meet if unable to prove his entry mark.
- PROTESTS:** Protests may be registered **IN WRITING within 15 minutes** at the protest table located at the southwest end of the stadium.
- TIME SCHEDULE:** No special calls will be announced for races. The schedule is only a guide. Competitors must be warmed-up and ready to compete for their event. **WATCH THE ORDER OF EVENTS. WE WILL GO AHEAD OF SCHEDULE WHEN POSSIBLE.**
- COMPETITORS** **Athletes and coaches will receive wrist bands. They must be worn at all times to enter the stadium, warm-up areas and track!**
- RUNWAYS** Pole vault, high jump, long jump, triple jump, and javelin runways are Joske SW rubber. Shot put and discus rings are concrete.
- FINISH LINE PROCEDURE:** All runners remain in their assigned lane at the finish line until they are released by the Finish Line Coordinator.
- DRESSING FACILITIES:** There are no showers available. Please come dressed for the competition.
- TRAINING ROOM:** Athletic training services will be provided in the at the northwest end of the stadium. Ice and emergency equipment will be available. Please bring any tape or other supplies needed. A physician will be on call.
- PARKING:** East and south of the stadium

Packet pick-up will be as follows: **Saturday, April 14 9:00 am – 10:30 am on the west side**

Entry fees are based on your initial roster. There will be no refunds.

No substitutions allowed after final declarations, only scratches. **Report scratches immediately following packet pick-up. There will be a designated area for scratches near the packet pick up.**

Report to event site check-in area at least 15 minutes before competition. Event check in will be at field event site and at warm-up area in parking lot northwest of the track.

Weigh-in area is in the W Room located under the west grandstand at the north end. High school shots will be furnished. **All implements must be checked in between 8:00am – 10:00am !!! No weigh –ins will be performed after 10:00am!**

Individual awards will be presented at the awards area located on the infield immediately at the end of the event.

Results will be posted on the east wall of the W-Club under the west side of the stadium. They will be updated as each event is completed. Results will be available on half-mile timing web-site immediately upon completion of the meet.

This year the meet will be conducted in one division and scored as one meet. All entries and will be seeded and heated according to entry marks! Inflating marks will not be tolerated and only hurts the quality of the meet!

To enhance the meet and assure that it runs off in a timely manner minimum distance marks have been established as follows.

MINIMUM DISTANCE LINES: All competitors will have their first throw or jump measured.
If fields are small all throws will be measured

All others will only be measured if they meet the minimum Distance Measurement and Starting Heights
